

# Are you ready in these scary times

## Passover: Your Salvation

---

- **Then:** In Exodus 11-13 a plague came over Egypt and killed the first born of every house except those who turned to God and repented. They were told to cover their doors with the blood of a perfect lamb without blemish sacrificed to God.
- **Today:** we are told there is a plague coming. We need to be ready. Repent and turn to God, purify our lives, and cover ourselves and our family with the spiritual blood of Christ the perfect sacrifice.
- **Are you ready?** In Exodus, even if they were Israelites that thought they would be saved because they were Israelites but didn't cover their doors with the blood were not protected. Only the Israelites that covered their doors with the blood were saved from the plague. So I ask again, **Are you ready?**
- **Get Ready:** God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son so that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. God gave his son so you would not perish but have eternal life. If you believe then ask God to forgive you by praying to Him. Have a conversation with him. Tell Him that you believe He gave His son Jesus Christ for you. Ask God to reveal himself to you and show you how to live for him. Then start reading the Bible. He wrote down all about Himself and you can know Him by reading His word.
- **Live for Him:** Now you gave your life to him. You are forgiven. Live like you are forgiven. As you read the Bible, He will show you how to live. Pray and ask Him to help you. Have conversations with your God who made Himself known to you.
- **Share with others:** Now he is changing your life. Pray for God to reveal Himself to those around you: as I have prayed that He would reveal Himself to you as I wrote this. I prayed to God that He would use me and I felt He wanted me to write this. Now that you are reading it, I know He is using me to teach you. In the same way, He will use you to reach others. Sometimes, it is scary to reach out but God goes with you and gives you the confidence, the words, and actions to do it. He is always with you. From that first prayer until the ends of the earth, He is with you.
