BELIN HONDURAS

What an experience! We were told that a local village about 30 miles from us needed a medical clinic. Dr Juan (a Honduran doctor we work with from time to time) told us that his church had recently discovered a village that had never heard the message of Christ. He said his church began making visits to the community and had built a church. He said that until they had

started going there no one had been working with the people or sharing the gospel.

It is really hard to believe that there are areas in the world that have never heard that Jesus Christ lives, but there are! Dr. Juan said that although his church was now working in the village there were many needs that they alone couldn't meet and would we consider working there. At that present time Henry said he would pray about it, but to be honest we have several areas we are already working in and didn't know when, if, or how we could.

We had a team in from NWA and they were going to do a medical clinic in a

(this just happened to be a day or two after Dr. Juan spoke with Henry.) Henry called up Dr. Juan and told him we were prepared to do a medical clinic and it was cancelled what did he think about us doing that in Belin (the community he mentioned.)

Dr. Juan was thrilled and even though he himself could not come he arranged for his pastor and some of their church members to

go with us. Ok so you think 30 miles no problem. We all loaded up and headed that way. Almost 2 hours later we got there. It is

amazing how different 30 miles of travel is in the states verses here.

It was amazing, we saw 171 people. There were many medical needs and most of these people hadn't seen a doctor or had medical care in years and there had never been a medical clinic in their village. We had a check-in area, a doctor, me, a dentist, a pharmacy, lice shampooing station, a haircutting station, and an evangelizing area. The people were thrilled we had come and we were blessed to be there!

After the clinic we (the team, staff, & church members) gathered in a circle and prayed for the community, sang worship songs, and talked of God's blessings of the day. During our praise & worship the pastor told us that 90% of the people that came through the evangelism area received Christ as their personal savior! This was phenomenal! He told us they wrote down names and information so that they can visit and disciple the people at least once a week besides the church service on Sunday! God is awesome! He opens so many doors for us to share him, to bless, & to be blessed!
