The wind took off the roof

Victory Farms has been a vision of HRM for many years and every time we have tried to drop it and move on something happens to show us to keep holding on to it. This past fall it was the donation of the tractor. We knew we were supposed to continue on with the vision and dream of Victory Farms. The house had begun to take form and the tractor arrived. However, the funding for the actual farm has been a little here and there and **the project has still yet to be funded.**



We decided that in God's time the funding will come and instead of waiting to have the startup funding to make this project happen and make it self-sustaining **we would just do what we can when we can.** Little by little we have added projects to the house (someone needs to be living on the farm full-time before the first harvest to protect the



harvest). The floor is completely in, the walls are completely up, the bathroom (outdoor) is built and when the door gets put on this week the toilet will be placed. The windows and doors are in the house. **We need to replace the roof** with a stronger tin (the wind took the other roof off

already). The land has been tilled twice by the tractor. The irrigation has been put in. Two types of corn have been planted and beans will be planted this week. This doesn't mean all the land we have available is planted but we are planting the land we have the funds to plant until we get the rest!
