Changing lives and planting seeds

If you ask kids in the States what they saw for themselves as they grew up you would hear "I will go to college and get a job in" Or "when I get out of high school I am going to get a job doing..." I asked the youth of Honduras the same question. I expected to hear something similar from them also.

I asked 10 to 12 year old boys in Honduras what they saw for themselves. Jose a 10 year old said when he got to be 15 or so he would likely work in the farm fields for someone, have kids with a few girls, drink when he had the money and that would be his life from then on.

I asked 8 to 12 year old girls what they saw for themselves and they all replied like Rosie age 10. When she is 13 or 14 she will probably have a baby and take care of it and then have other babies. That is all she saw for herself.

I would like to say that this is an exception; but in Honduras in the areas where we minister, this is the usual and not the exception. With minimal public schools only going to 6th grade and few biblical values taught in the home or at school, this is the normal outlook and cultural perspective. Higher education, even secondary education is out of reach for most children.



We are so grateful in first place with God, and with Melissa and Dean Lowman for the great opportunity that Dayana has to be able to go to Abundant Life Christian School, to learn everyday about God and also to learn English, that for this days is something really important, so when she grows up she would be able to find good opportunities. She is so happy and wants to say Thank you for your support, she loves the school, she loves to ride on the bus, and she enjoys learning every day, hope one day to be able to talk to you in English. She says Thank you Melissa for everything. You are a Blessing to our family.
