Dear Potential Partner:

Allow me to introduce Heaven's Reach Ministries. Founded as a 501c3 in 2004, HRM was the first step in my process of becoming a missionary. My wife, Melissa, and I left our secular positions in 2007 after years of participating in short term missions in the US and abroad. Through several confirmations we were led to Honduras. There, we fell in love with the people and started to help the poor. We started receiving equipment even before we moved to Honduras in 2006.

From 2007 to 2011, we worked under Mercy International. We left MI with experience and insight into the work and challenges of missions. We now turn our focus to our passions. Melissa is working on Medical clinics, refurbishing and reequipping the local public hospital and giving medical assistance to the poor improving their access to medical care. I am working on food security, nutrition, and sustainable agriculture.

We have formed "Ministerios Alcanzando Desde El Cielo" the Heaven's Reach Ministries' NGO in Honduras in 2011. We now have the ability to receive physical donations and ship them to Honduras tax free including medical supplies and vehicles. Our working relationships with the Hospital and the Department of Health led us to introduce new medical procedures to Honduras improving health care. These relationships are allowing continuous progress and have led to an invitation to start a program called Sustainable Healthy Living. We are excited to see our passions come to pass as we work under this NGO.

In addition to the other projects we hold pastor conferences and this year we have added XploreNations a four year seminary to our programs. All of these programs are now in both La Esperanza and Gracias. Our vision includes a demonstration farm, Victory Farms, empowering the substance farmers to adequately and sustainably feed their families. We pray that you also will come along side of us and become a partner in this work.

Current Programs

Health Care Assistance: This program provides medical assistance: (for visits, medicines, exams, & medical clinics) for those that could not otherwise afford it.

Hospital Refurbishment: This program helps the local public hospital that is exceedingly underfunded to become better in facilities, equipment and service which gives us the opportunity to inject Christ into the hospital environment. The current project is to reroof the hospital to stop leaks that are currently falling onto patient beds.

Sustainable Healthy Living: This program teaches Godly living, hygiene, nutrition, cooking, and gardening and gives vegetable seed to pregnant women at the hospital. Plans have been made to introduce this program to other hospitals around the country of Honduras.

The participants of this program receive the production of a garden we have on the Hospital grounds and heirloom seeds that will produce seeds during the harvest; making this program sustainable. This program gives these families access to vitamins and minerals through the vegetables they grow with these seeds.

Victory Farms: this program is a self sustaining demonstration farm that will be start in 2012. This farm will do three things.

1. **Demonstrate organic farming:** using new ways to farm will increase production and quality empowering the local farmers to live better as most of them live off the land including producing their own fertilizer.
2. **Produce Seed:** part of the farm will be dedicated to reproducing seeds for the Sustainable Healthy Living program which will be given away.
3. **Employ unemployed farmers:** employing local farmers who are out of work or have land but do not have recourses to plant enabling them to utilize their land.

This farm will be run as a social business with the goal to affect social change not momentary profit under our Honduran NGO.

Progress in La Esperanza

We started our time home by receiving Helen Redmond and Esther McMasters and having a Ladies conference that touched the lady pastors and pastor's wives of La Esperanza.

We then received Pastor Karen Hartung and her son Brandon Hartung. They brought \$2,000 to buy lab supplies for the Hospital in La Esperanza. Here we are presenting the director of the lab with a symbolic check and the supplies.



Progress in Gracias



Karen has a heart for the ladies in the Alberge (expecting mother's dorm) in Gracias. We replanted the garden there and met with several people about using land in Gracias for an extended garden and part of the Victory Farms Program.

Brandon is the videographer that made our videos last year, and has blessed us with another visit to continue producing vision casting videos for us on his trip. Karen also spoke several places and gave moving messages in churches and home small groups.

Victory Farms is more than a place to grow produce. It will house a bible school, regeneration center and produce seed that we give away to expecting mothers and a teaching center for subsistence farmers.

The Bible school was launched this month in La Esperanza and Gracias in partnership with Xplorenations a four year university program from Heritage University in Florida. The participants will receive a Diploma from Heritage when they complete 360 hours of teaching. This program combines Live and video teaching with community project application. We currently have 40 students. When the Victory Farms building is in place we will move the teaching to the ministry center.

Heaven's Reach Ministries relies on donations from people like you. Donations as small as \$5 a month will help us give seed to the hungry.
